

Gospel Connection: In an episode of Lynn Johnston's comic strip *For Better or For Worse* [December 27, 2015], seven-year-old Michael is holding an old, scratched miner's helmet. It's the day after Christmas, and Michael is disappointed. "An old hard hat," Michael moans. "What a dumb thing for Grandpa to give me for Christmas." "Didn't you read the card, Mike?" his dad asks. "He said it was something special he wanted you to have." Michael's father goes on to explain the story of the hat: "My dad worked in the mine for thirty years. He risked his life sometimes to feed us . . . put my brother and sister and me through school. He wore this every day. It was a part of him. When your grandpa is gone, you'll have this to remember him by. Treasure it." Michael is next seen outside meeting up with his buddies. "Hey, Mike! Get anything neat for Christmas?!!" they ask. "Yeah! This!" Michael says, proudly wearing his grandpa's miner's helmet. And Mike begins to tell the story of the helmet.

Today's Gospel from Matthew is the beginning of Jesus' teaching ministry in Galilee. Jesus begins to tell the story of God's love for his people, a love that Jesus reveals in the compassion and healing of the "kingdom of God" - a "kingdom" that does not belong to some distant future but is part of our here and now. Like the fishermen he calls, Jesus calls us now to remember and tell the story of God's love in our midst - love that is manifested in every act of generous sacrifice and selfless compassion. Just ask young Michael about his Christmas present.
