Old Business:

Recap of Soup and Sandwich Supper: Just held this evening. Went very well. Approx 105 people attended. Free Will donation: for Poor Clare's after expenses: 864.00 collect - \$96.00 groceries expenses + 500.00 match from CUPVT = 1268.00 approx will be donated to Poor Clare's. Serve from 5:30 – 7:15 Mass at 7:30 pm

Groceries: 2 choc/3 white milk; 8 small cans of chicken; 3 doz eggs; 5 rings bologna; 14 soups; 1 box crackers. Had plenty food.

Nickotoberfest News: The St Nicholas Nicks amateur baseball team will do the food for the event as a fundraiser for the baseball park. Everyone was excited to hear this. The food committee will touch base their reps from the baseball team to sort out details.

Disbursing the profits from Nicktoberfest: Since we have received the monies from CU for the matching grant, we will remit a check to St Nickolas Parish for the profits from Nicktoberfest (approx. 4600.00) + the 1000.00 to help with funding Religious Education.

Christmas Program at Theis' Barn: The Christmas program tentatively to be held this year has been canceled due to time constraints. Discussion will be held with appropriate parties in 2023 if program/play can be held at Christmas 2023.

Rosary on KASM: Payment was made for funding the rosary on KASM. Our week will be mid-January.

Regional Member Gathering: Annette and Dave Stang attended this event back in October in Rogers, MN. About 35 people attended. Nice gathering that takes place the 2 years between the triennial Catholic United conference.

Nativity Statutes Refurbished: Mary and Doug Caskey took care of finding an artist to refurbish/paint the parishes nativity statues. They will be back for this year's Christmas season. CUPVT used the money from last year's soup and sandwich supper and added the balance from our account to pay for this.

New Business:

Religious Education Supper: Discussion was held to provide the supper to RE families for one of the upcoming classes. Dave Stang reported that he will be holding a "Young Family's Workshop" and coordinate both be held on the same night.

March 2023: Food Shelf Battles: Kelly spoke to the committee about having a Food Shelf Donation Battle with Kimball in March 2023. She will work out the details with them. We will try to create a "Traveling Trophy" for the winning team.

Sharing the meeting minutes on the parish's website: Mike asked about maybe putting the minutes of this group's meeting on the website. Everyone thought that was a good idea. He will add them 1 week after they are sent to members, plus try to add the past meeting's minutes in an archived folder on the website.
